PROCESS FOR CHANGING SACRAMENTO AREA SEWER DISTRICT MASTER PLAN TRUNK SHED BOUNDARIES INTERIM SHED SHIFT

It is unlikely that an interim shed shift will warrant a change to the District Master Plan. However, the following process is to ensure adequate review and documentation of any considered change to the District Master Plan.

1. The Developer/Engineer (originator) prepares a brief description and justification for the proposed shed shift change and submits **five** copies of the attached District Master Plan Interim Shed Shift Request Form along with the supporting documentation.
2. The supporting documentation shall include a clean copy showing the most current Master Plan alignment **AND** a revised copy showing the proposed shed shift alignment. And must include the following:
 - Clean copy of Shed Map & Revised copy of Shed Map
 - Existing Master Plan facilities and proposed interim facility changes. (Pump stations, force mains, trunks, etc.)
 - Duration of the interim shed shift and interim facilities.
 - Describe any permanent facilities that may be required.
 - Clean copy of Master Plan Model Results Table(s) & Revised copy of Master Plan Model Results Table(s) (*i.e.*, ESDs, landuse, pipe size, pipe alignment, phasing, inverts, etc.)
 - Clean copy of plan and profile & Revised copy of plan and profile
 - Clean copy of cost estimates for each shed & Revised copy of cost estimates for each shed
 - Clean copy of summary of overall cost, total change in Peak Wet Weather Flows, Acreage, and ESDs & Revised copy of summary of overall cost, total change in Peak Wet Weather Flows, Acreage, and ESDs

Once the submittal is received, it will be reviewed and routed internally to various sections for recommendations. The originator will be notified upon approval or denial.
